# Explanations

This form is designed for working with church books. If one is looking for a family in a church register, usually the first step would be to use the index of the book and write down all relevant persons with the family name. Subsequently, one can look through them in detail one by one and enter the person in the family tree.

This form will help making such a list from the church book index (Surname, parish and book can be filled in on the top of the form).

The column „Name“ in the table below is intended for entering first names of persons in the index.

Beside the obligatory „Folio“ (which is the relevant page in the register), indices often also contain other interesting data such as a year or an address. These can be entered in the table in the columns „Address“ and „Year“.

If an entry has been analyzed in detail in the church book, the column „ok“ can be marked. If the index entry is not relevant for your research, tick „no“.

If after analyzing an entry, you are still not sure, whether the person is relevant (maybe a distant cousin?), you can postpone to „later“.

The column „Comment“ leaves room for all other information available in the church book index (e.g. sometimes names of parents are mentioned in baptismal book's indices) as well as for all other personal comments.
